Thank You for sending Jesus to show us how much You love us. Thank You that Jesus died for each one of us on the cross. Praise You that You gave Jesus the power to come


back to life at Easter to beat death, the devil and all the bad, hurtful things in life. Thank You that there is no-one and nothing more powerful than You! Amen.

Let them know that their loved ones who died are with Jesus in heaven where they will see them again one day. Then they will live forever with You dear God and there will be no more suffering, death, tears, sadness or pain - only the joy and delight of Your great love! Amen.
